1. Date: September 7, 2026, 10:00 AM.

3. Purpose of the selection:

The purpose of this informal selection is to recruit guest ballet dancers for artistic activities during the 2026–2027 season.

- Candidates must be at least 18 years old.
- Specialized studies in choreography

5. Selection process:

The selection will take place during a ballet class, evaluating candidates' technical preparation, artistic expressivity, musicality, and performance skills. The second stage will consist of presenting a dance variation of the candidate's choice.

Candidate entry is permitted based on an ID card.

Candidates are kindly asked to arrive at least 30 minutes before the selection begins, dressed in appropriate practice wear.

Selected candidates must be available for artistic activities during the 2026–2027 season.
